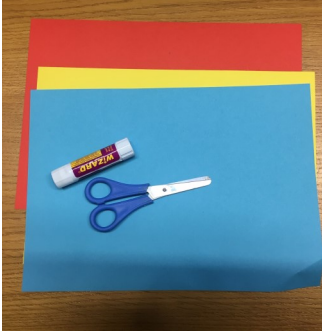
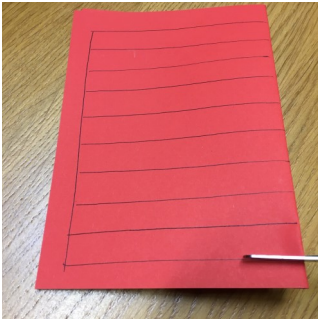


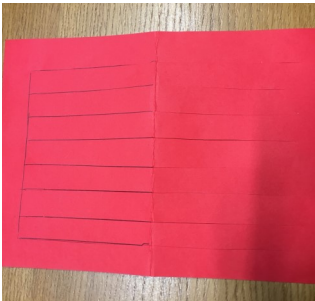
PAPER WEAVING



1. You will need: paper in various colours, glue, and scissors.



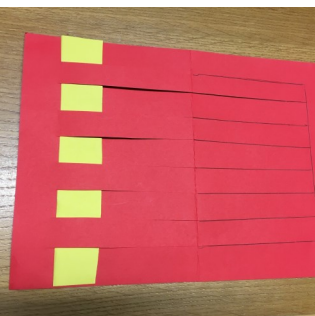
2. Fold the paper in half and cut evenly spaced slits, (you can draw lines as a guide) approx. 1" wide starting from the folded edge and stopping about 1" from the opposite edge.



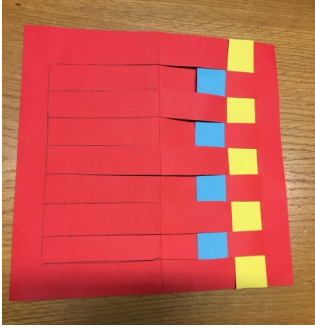
3. Unfold the paper.



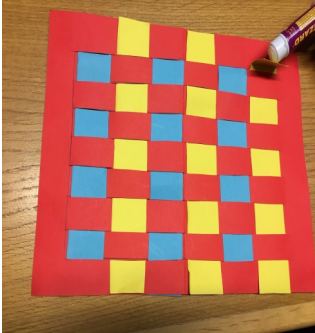
4. Cut coloured paper strips approximately 1" wide and 10" long.



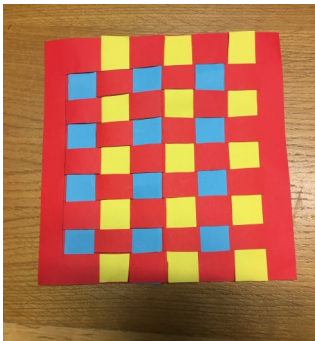
5. Weave the first strip (take one paper strip and weave it across the slits, going over and under the slits).



8. Weave the second strip in an opposite pattern as the first. If your first strip went over and under the slits, the second strip should go under and over the slits.



9. Continue to weave the rest of the slits using alternating pattern. Then carefully flip the paper square over so that the back is facing up and glue down the ends of each paper strip.



10. You have finished your design and it is now ready to be displayed.
