

BM&AG ART OPEN 2026 - How to add mirror plates to picture frames

THE ARTWORK

Due to restrictions on space each artist is limited to one submission.

- **Maximum size of wall mounted works - 100cm x 100cm.**
- **All pieces submitted must be original and the artist's own work. The artist is responsible for ensuring there is no infringement of copyright.**
- **You cannot submit on behalf of someone else.**

The artist must write the following information on a label and attach it securely to the work before submission. This information will appear in the exhibition catalogue and on any promotional material:

ARTIST'S NAME
TITLE OF WORK
MEDIUM USED
PRICE - if for sale

Please also write the artists name and title of the piece on the reverse of the artwork for identification purposes.

DO NOT WRITE PERSONAL OR CONTACT DETAILS ON LABELS OR DIRECTLY ONTO WORK



EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Pair of mirror plates appropriate to the size of the artwork - one for either side - plus associated screws (mirror plates are typically either 32mm x 32mm or 38 x 38mm in size).
- Measuring tape or a ruler
- Pencil
- Screwdriver



FIXING MIRROR PLATES:

- Turn the artwork over so you can see the reverse.
- Using your pencil and measure, mark a point to indicate where the mirror plates will be fixed
- Place the top hole over the mark, using the pencil, mark up the place of the other hole on the frame.
- Using two screws - and the guide marks - screw the mirror plates to the frame.
