They wear Blackburn with Darwen Council's green and blue lanyards.

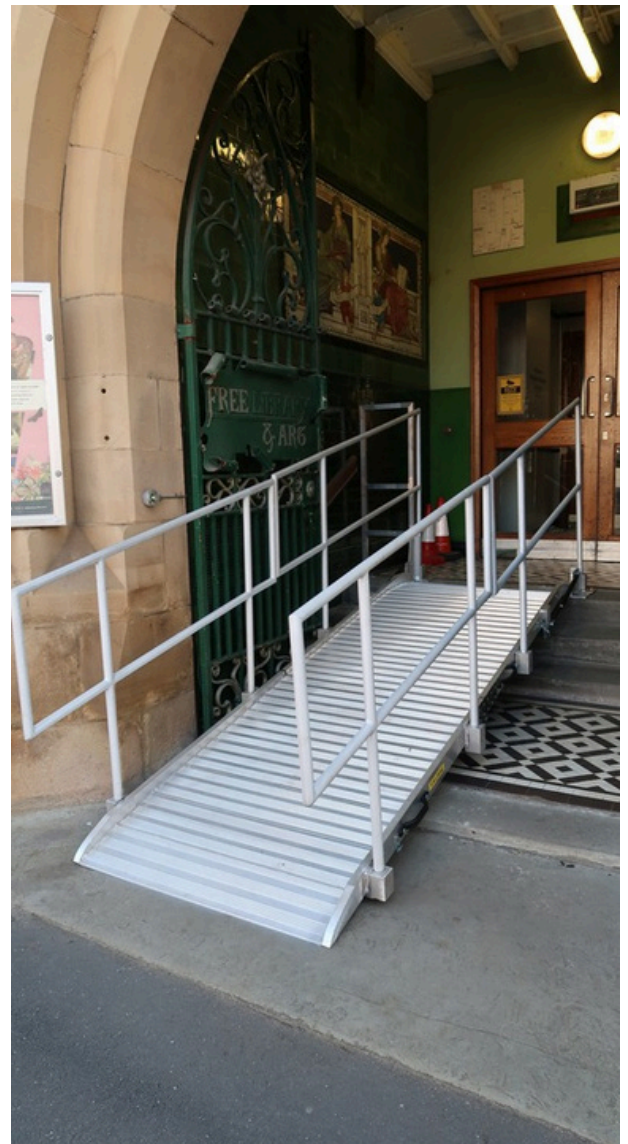




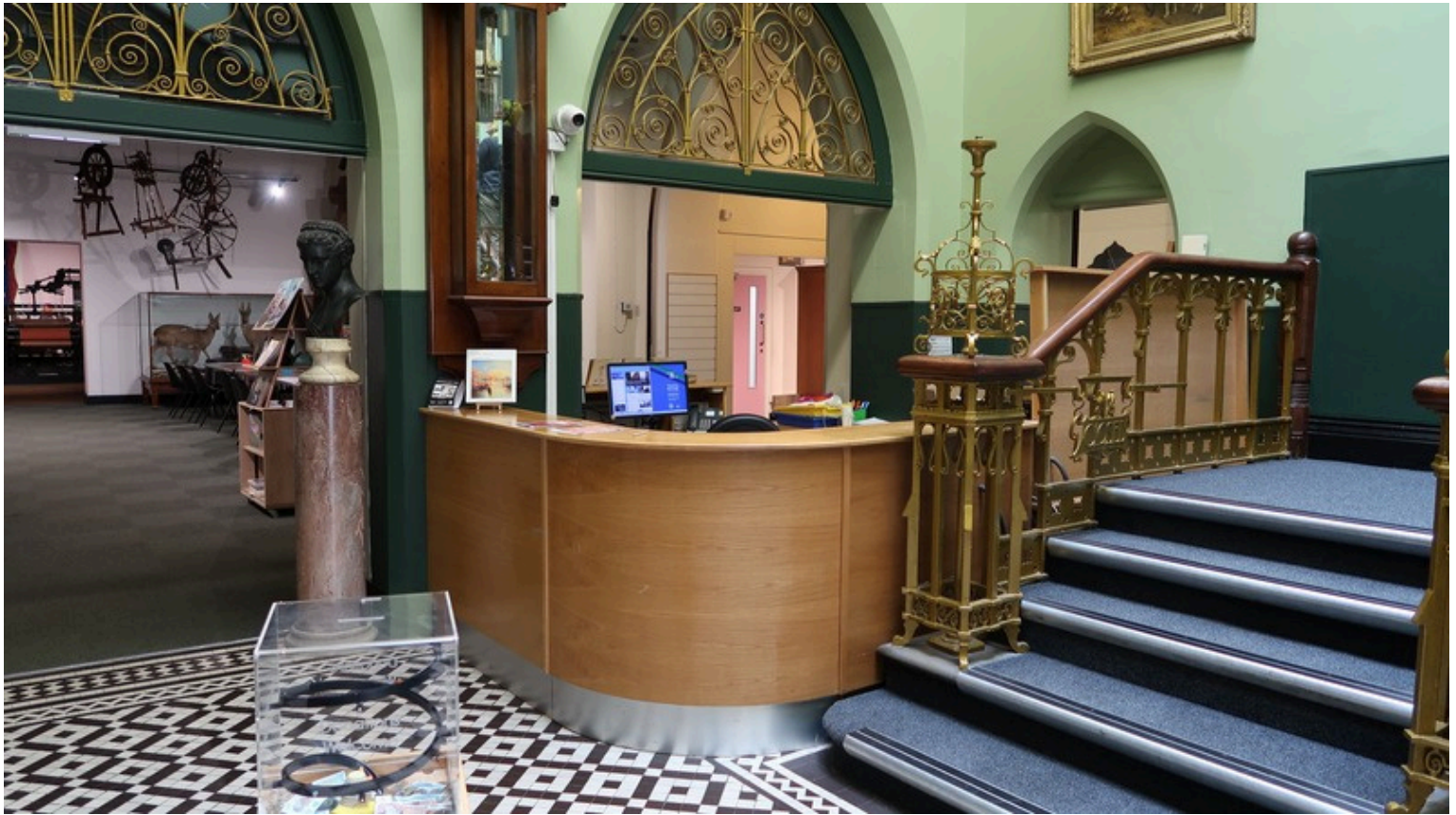
We are located on Museum St.

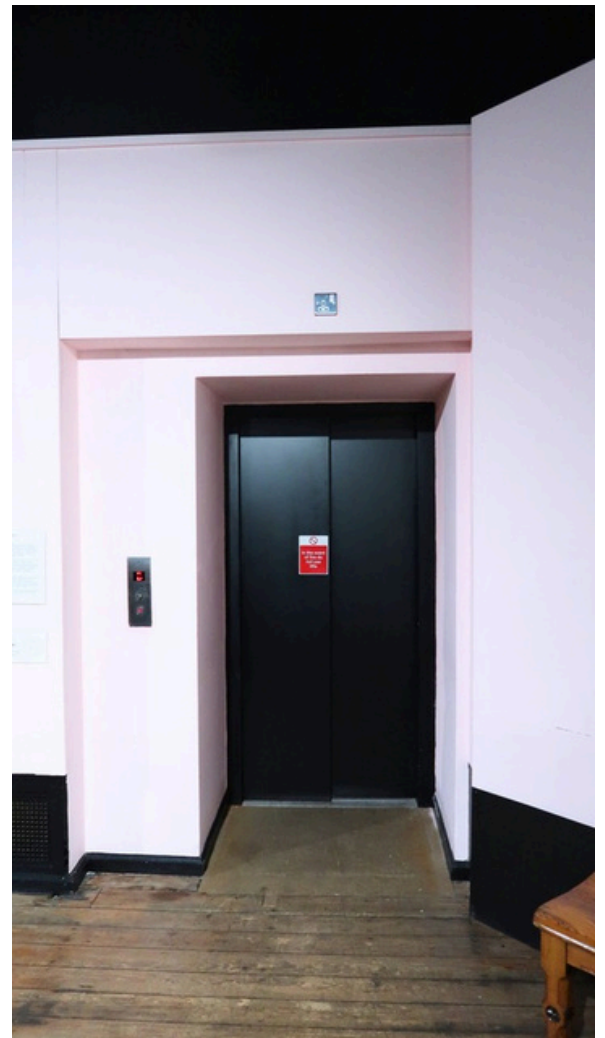

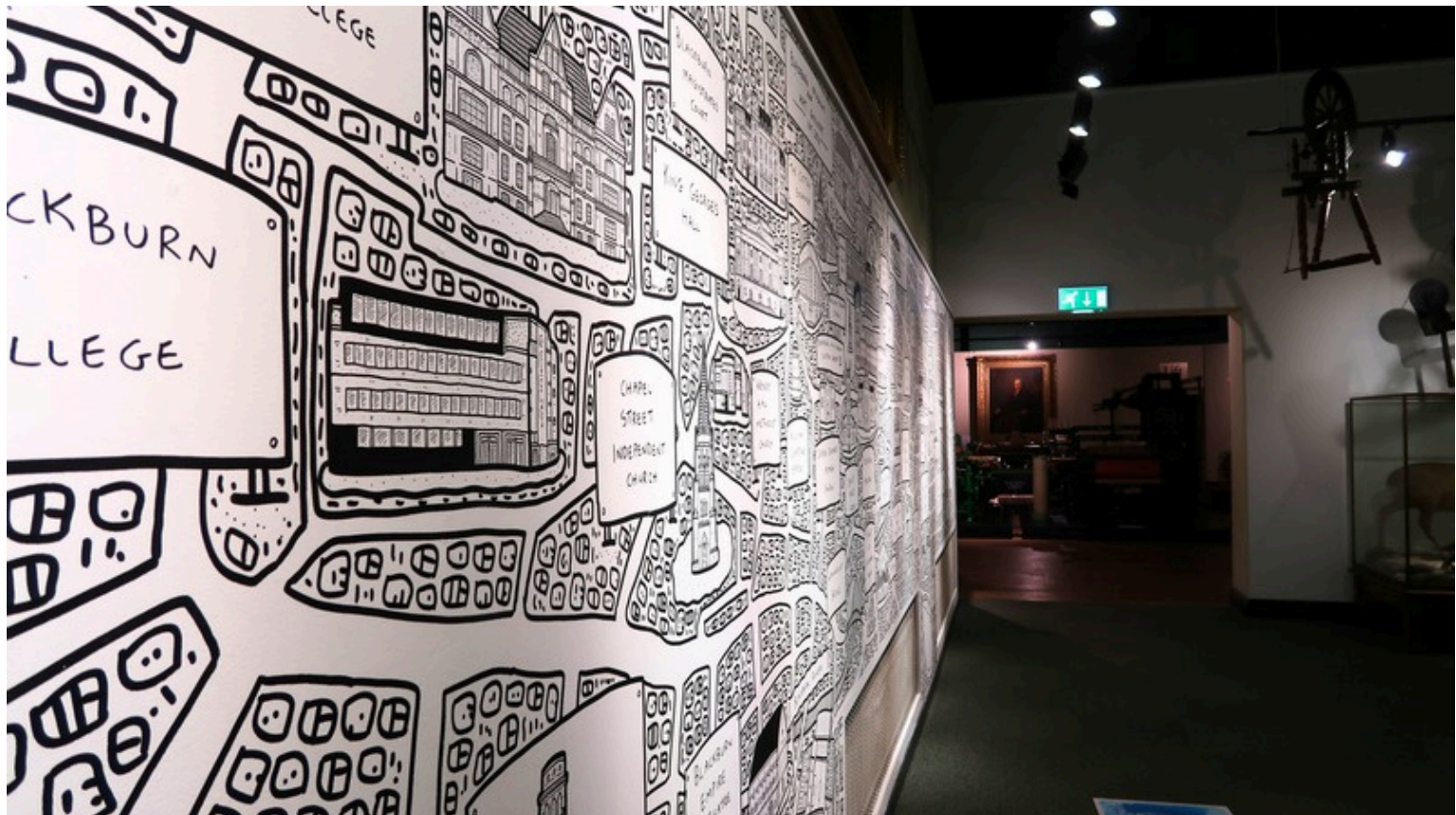
There are stairs near our entrance

The lift is through our cotton town gallery, towards the back of the building.

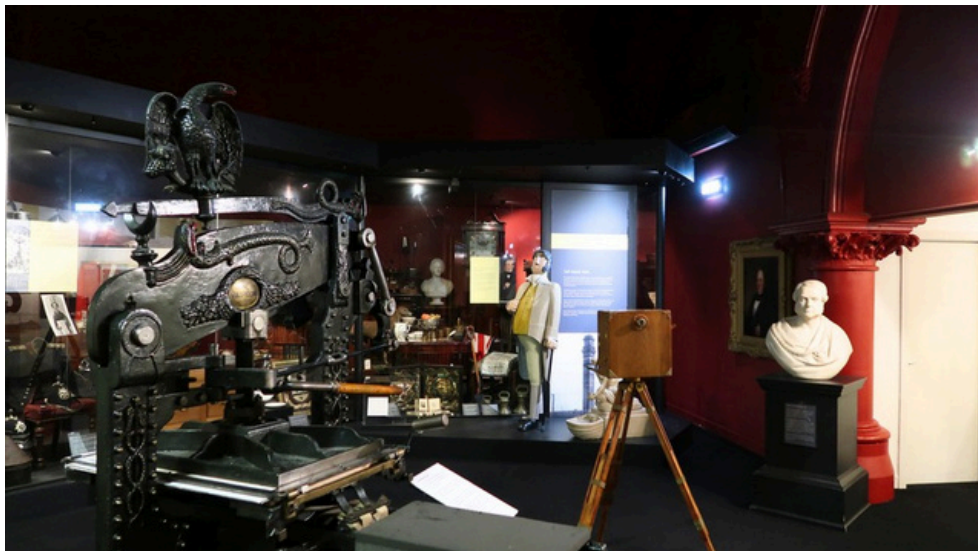

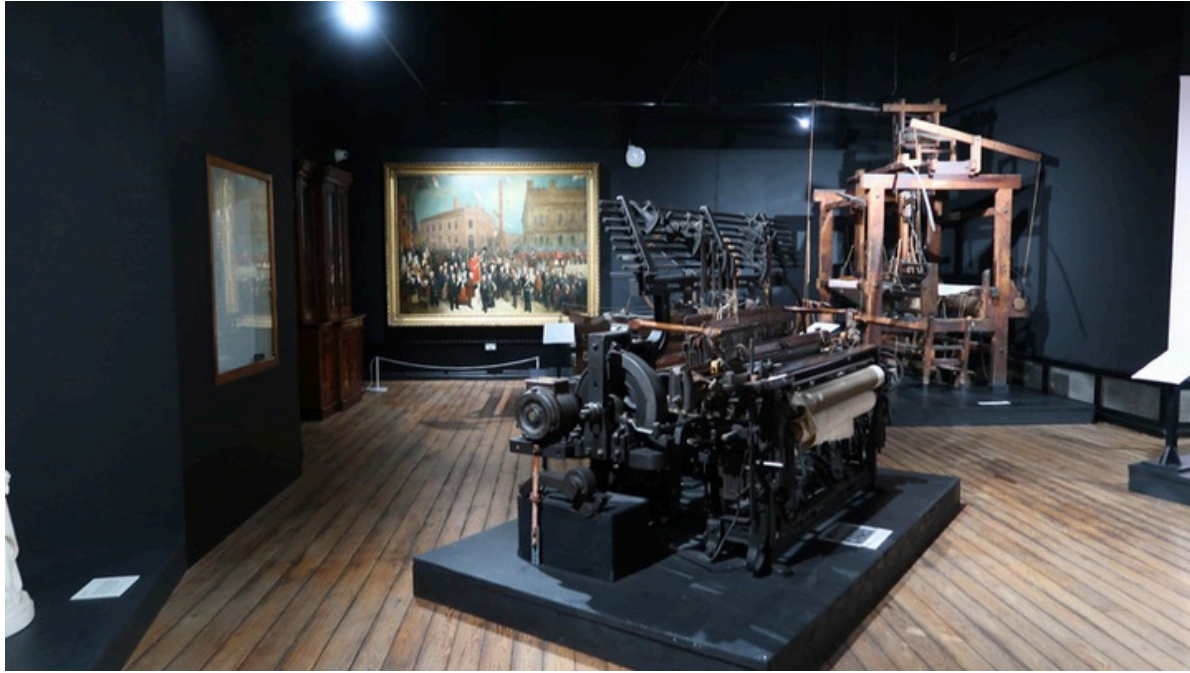

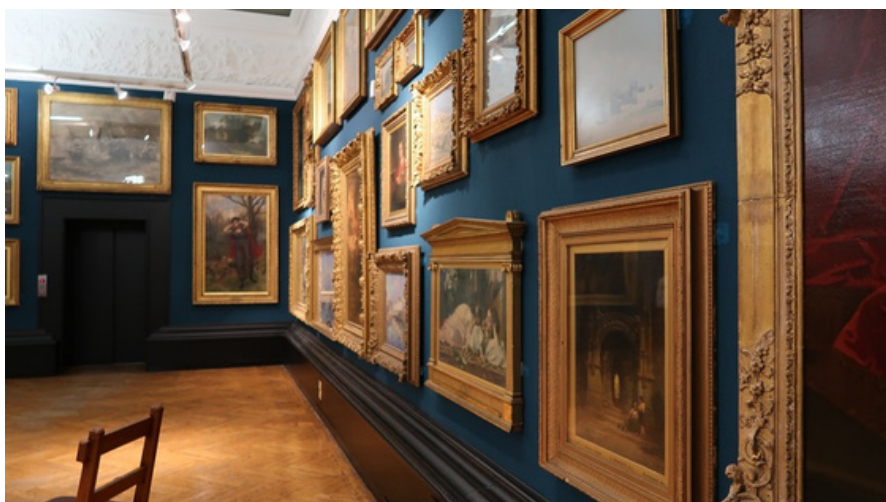
